

## MAINTENANCE TIPS

Taking care of your airsoft replicas is essential to ensure optimal performance and long-lasting durability. Whether you're a beginner or an experienced player, knowing the basics of maintenance will help you avoid failures in the field and maintain the reliability of your gear. After each game session, it's good practice to clean the exterior of the weapon with a soft cloth to remove dust, mud, or residue. Pay special attention to moving parts like pistol slides or the hop-up unit in rifles, which can jam if neglected. For the inner barrel, we recommend regular cleaning using proper rods and microfiber cloths. Always use specific products, avoiding harsh substances that could damage plastic or rubber components.

Also periodically check the batteries and wiring of electric replicas: make sure there are no exposed wires, oxidation, or loose connections. During periods of inactivity, store lithium batteries in cool, dry places at half charge to preserve their health. Lightly lubricate the gears and friction points with silicone oil. Avoid mineral oils, which can prematurely wear out seals. With a few simple regular actions, your airsoft pistols and rifles will always be ready for action. Keep performance high—start with care!

## ONLY QUALITY SPARE PARTS

Using only quality spare parts for airsoft replicas is essential for those who want reliable and long-lasting performance. Every component, even the smallest one, affects the overall function of the weapon. Don't leave your gear's quality to chance—every detail matters, especially in decisive moments.

## REMEMBER, PLAY SAFELY

- **Always protect your eyes** – The use of certified protective goggles is mandatory. Never remove them during a match, not even for a few seconds. Accidental shots to the eyes can cause serious damage.
- **Wear appropriate clothing** – Long pants, gloves, sturdy shoes, and face masks help protect the body from close-range shots, scratches, and falls.
- **Respect engagement distances** – Each field sets rules on minimum shooting distances, especially with powerful replicas. Respecting them avoids unnecessary injuries.
- **Check your replica's power** – Make sure it complies with legal limits and field specifications. Replicas must be chrono-tested to ensure other players' safety.

- **Follow field rules** – Listen to the initial briefing, respect the referees, and don't question decisions made for common safety.
- **Always maintain sportsmanship** – No physical contact, no insults, and outside the field keep your replica unloaded, with the safety on and no BBs in the magazine.

Playing safe means truly having fun, respecting yourself and others.
